

Cultural Information – Disporum

(dy-SPOR-um)

Hardy to Zones 5-9 for outdoors.
Partial sun, grows to 5' in container, blooms in spring.

<u>Light:</u>	Partial sun, an eastern or western exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Hardy to sub zero temperatures when planted in the ground.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Humidity is not an issue. They like a moist spot.
<u>Watering:</u>	They like a moist spot. Once established they are enduring subjects.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Little if any fertilizer needed unless the soil is extremely poor.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Old cans can be removed once the growing season is finished with a new set emerging the following spring.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Few problems with insects or diseases.
<u>Comments</u>	Disporum are interesting garden subjects for the shade garden that have a bamboo look. They are easy to cultivate and can be used as a centerpiece in garden designs as the height is often dominating.
