

Cultural Information – Trachelospermum

(tray-key-low-SPER-mum)

Hardy to Zone 8 and higher for outdoors.

Full to partial sun, grows 1-2' in container, minimum temperature 35°, blooms in spring and summer.

<u>Light:</u>	Full to partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 35°; however, they will tolerate low levels periodically. Winter hardiness outdoors of Zone 8.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Preferably 50% or higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
<u>Watering:</u>	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Go easy on the fertilizer. Apply monthly during spring through fall during active growth. Use ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Prune only when needed to maintain size. The best time to prune is after flowering in late summer.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Resistant to most insects; occasional mealy bug problems. Not susceptible to root disease.
<u>Comments</u>	Easy-to-grow, tolerant to drought stress and low humidity. Train on a stake or trellis to make it into a beautiful specimen.
