## <u>Cultural Information- Burbidgea</u> (bur-BIDJ-ee-a)

<u>Light:</u>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure. Some direct sunlight is beneficial however; direct midday sun is too strong for best growth.
Temperature:	Maintain temperatures above 60°; they will tolerate cooler temperatures but they become more susceptible to diseases.
Humidity:	Preferably 50% or higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
Watering:	Bring the soil to a state of visual dryness between watering however, they do not mind even moisture.
Fertilizer:	Fertilize sparingly, too much fertilizer can hurt them. Use ¼ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water every two months of a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like Dyna-Gro Liquid Grow Plant Food 7-9-5.
Pruning:	Only prune off old stems once they have finished flowering and look unsightly, when plants get too large, divide them, which can be done at any time.
Insects and Disease:	Some susceptibility to mealy bug.
Comments:	Burbidgeas are excellent potted plants, bringing a burst of color twice a year. They are easy to grow, being only sensitive to excessive fertilization.
