

Cultural Information –
Adenia

<u>Light:</u>	Full to partial sun, south east or western exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 45°.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Humidity is not an issue in its culture
<u>Watering:</u>	Bring the soil to visual dryness between waterings during the active growing season. During winter plant can be kept dryer where the soil is allowed to dry out completely.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Feed during the active growing season with a balanced fertilizer. They are not heavy feeders but do benefit from some fertilizer. Once a month is usually adequate.
<u>Pruning:</u>	The vining stems can be pruned as need to contain the size and height.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Mealybugs and thrip can be a problem
<u>Comments</u>	An easy caudiciform to grow. Grow in a well drained potting mix and during the winter when not in active growth and temperatures are cooler grow dryer.
