

**Cultural Information – Albuca**  
 (AL-buh-kuh)

<b><u>Light:</u></b>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
<b><u>Temperature:</u></b>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 60°.
<b><u>Humidity:</u></b>	Likes a dry environment
<b><u>Watering:</u></b>	Water only when the soil is dry and then thoroughly saturate the mix until some water trickles from the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help ensure a healthy root system.
<b><u>Fertilizer:</u></b>	Feed only during active growth and then go easy. Excessive fertilizer will make soft growth and encourages rot. Use a low balanced fertilizer no higher than 15-15-15.
<b><u>Pruning:</u></b>	Little need for pruning except to remove old leaves or flower spikes.
<b><u>Insects and Disease:</u></b>	Few problems with insects. Susceptible to root and bulb rots if kept too wet.
<b><u>Comments</u></b>	An interesting plant to grow in a sunny dry window. Does not like damp cool conditions as this encourages rot. Growing in clay pot helps with the disease issues.
