| <u>Light:</u> | Full to partial sun; a southern, eastern or western exposure. |
| <u>Temperature:</u> | Maintain temperatures above 40°. Under cool temperatures grow dry. |
| <u>Humidity:</u> | Will tolerate wide swings in humidity without harm. Avoid wet soil and foliage when temperatures are cool. |
| <u>Watering:</u> | Water when soil is dry. Keep drier in the winter when temperatures are cool and then thoroughly saturate the soil until some water trickles from the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help ensure a healthy root system. |
| <u>Fertilizer:</u> | Light feeders. Feed once a month with a dilute solution of a low balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or lower in summer when temperatures are warm and light is high. Reduce or eliminate fertilizer in winter or to control size. |
| <u>Pruning:</u> | Plants can be pruned back any time growth is active to maintain size. |
| <u>Insects and Disease:</u> | Few problems with insects with the exception of mealybug. Diseases are only an issue if grown wet under cool temperatures. |
| <u>Comments</u> | An easy-to-grow succulent that endures dryness with ease. Grow in good light for the best results. |
