

Cultural Information- Blechnum
(BLEK-num)

<u>Light:</u>	Partial sun, an eastern or western exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain temperatures above 60°.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Preferably 50% or higher; however, prefers high humidity.
<u>Watering:</u>	Keep evenly moist. The fronds suffer if they dry out too much. Having them sit in water will help keep them moist.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	They are light feeders; ¼ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a month. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or Dyna-Gro Liquid Grow Plant Food 7-9-5.
<u>Pruning:</u>	If the fronds die, simply trim them.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Susceptible to scale and root rot.
<u>Comments:</u>	These are great indoor plants that don't require a lot of light but do require attention to watering and humidity.
