

Cultural Information- Cordyline
(kor-di-LY-nee)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, partial sun, or shade, a southern, eastern, western or northern exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 50°. Will tolerate temperatures. Maintain below freezing into the high 20's.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Best to maintain humidity above 50% although it will tolerate lower levels without harm.
<u>Watering:</u>	Bring the soil to visual dryness between waterings and then thoroughly saturate. Tolerant of wide swings in soil moisture.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Moderate feeders under warmth and high light. Feed with a balanced fertilizer no higher than a 15-15-15 at regular intervals through it active growing season. For northern growers, discontinue during the winter.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Prune any time height is excessive. Pruning does help create a multi-branched specimen.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Insects or diseases do not bother them.
<u>Comments:</u>	Cordyline are easy plants to grow and tolerate a wide range of environmental conditions. They are, however, somewhat slow growing.
