

Cultural Information – Cremnosedum
(krem-noh-SEE-dum)

<u>Light:</u>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 60°.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Tolerant to a wide range of humidity.
<u>Watering:</u>	Bring to visual dryness between watering and then thoroughly saturate. Grow on the dry side. Water more in summer and less during the winter.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Feed with low fertilizer levels during active growth in the summer with a balanced fertilizer no higher than 15-15-15. Discontinue in winter or when light levels are low.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Little pruning is needed.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Few problems with insects. Can have root disease problem if kept too wet.
<u>Comments</u>	Easy to grow. Tolerant of neglect and dry conditions. Needs good light and some direct sun to do well.
