

Cultural Information – Drosera
(DROSS-er-uh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun is necessary, a southern exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain a minimum temperature of 40°. Although they can tolerate cool temperatures, it is better to keep them above 60° for active growth.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Preferably 50% or higher; however, since they are grown in water, humidity is not an issue.
<u>Watering:</u>	They are bog plants and need to be kept moist at all times. <u>It's best to grow them in a saucer of water.</u> Also, use non-chlorinated water to improve their growth.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Little to no fertilizer is preferred. Too much fertilizer can harm them.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Pruning is not necessary.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	They capture insects and are not bothered by insects.
<u>Comments</u>	Keep them wet with pure, clean water for best growth.
