

Cultural Information – Faradaya

<u>Light:</u>	Full to partial sun
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain temperatures above 40°
<u>Humidity:</u>	Generally maintain humidity above 50% Although it will tolerate lower levels for short periods with no harm.
<u>Watering:</u>	As with most container plants it's best to bring the soil to visual dryness between watering and then thoroughly saturate the container.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Fertilize regularly with a balance fertilizer from Spring to fall. Be cautious not to over feed nitrogen as it will make the plant vegetate rather than flower.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Pruning should be done after the flowering cycle is complete to allow the growth to mature going into fall and winter to make spring blooms.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	There are a few problems with insects although mealybug can be an issue is plants nearby are already infected. In our culture disease has not been an issue with either the foliage or roots.
<u>Comments</u>	The Glory Vine is a large heavy grower that need space to mature and flower. We grow it in a cool greenhouse down to 50° at night and it seems to prefer that, flowering better that in our warm greenhouses. The flowering occurs in the spring on the wood of late summer, so it is important not to prune late in the season.
