

Cultural Information – Nepenthes
(nep-EN-theez)

<u>Light:</u>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain a minimum temperature above 50°. Although they can tolerate cool temperatures, it is better to keep them above 60° for active growth.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Preferably 50% or higher, the more the better as the pitchers for better under high humidity.
<u>Watering:</u>	They come from tropical rainforests and need constant moisture at their roots; using pure low mineral, non-chlorinated water will improve their growth and ensure proper development of pitchers.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Little or no fertilizer, as they prefer low fertility. Too much would harm them!
<u>Pruning:</u>	Not required.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	For the most part, insects or diseases do not harm them.
<u>Comments</u>	Keep them wet with pure, clean water for best growth.
