

Cultural Information – Sarracenia
(sar-uh-SEN-ee-uh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, a southern exposure is ideal.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 40°. They can tolerate cool temperatures, but it is better to keep them above 60° if active growth is desired.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Preferably 50% or higher; however, they grow in water so humidity is usually not a concern.
<u>Watering:</u>	They are bog plants and need to be kept moist at all times. <u>It's best to grow them in a saucer of water.</u> In addition, using non-chlorinated water will improve their growth.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Little or no fertilizer, as they prefer low fertility. Too much would harm them!
<u>Pruning:</u>	If pitchers die, cut them off.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	They capture insects and are not bothered by them. For the most part, diseases do not bother them.
<u>Comments</u>	Keep them wet with pure, clean water for best growth.
