

Cultural Information – Scaevola
(skee-VOH-luh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, a southern exposure.
<u>Temperature:</u>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 40°.
<u>Humidity:</u>	Preferably 50% or higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
<u>Watering:</u>	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
<u>Fertilizer:</u>	Fertilize with ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a week. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5.
<u>Pruning:</u>	Prune anytime growth is excessive or in the spring or late winter so as to not disrupt flowering.
<u>Insects and Disease:</u>	Resistant to most insects and diseases.
<u>Comments</u>	Flowers in the longer day-length of summer. A great plant for summer mixed containers or hanging baskets. They need warmer light to flower well and high soil fertility.
