

**Cultural Information – Serissa**  
*(ser-ISS-uh)*

<b><u>Light:</u></b>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
<b><u>Temperature:</u></b>	Maintain indoor temperatures above 50°.
<b><u>Humidity:</u></b>	Preferably 50% or higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
<b><u>Watering:</u></b>	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
<b><u>Fertilizer:</u></b>	They are light feeders: ¼ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water every other week. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5. When growth stops in winter, discontinue feeding.
<b><u>Pruning:</u></b>	Takes pruning with ease. Often used in bonsai culture.
<b><u>Insects and Disease:</u></b>	Few insect problems.
<b><u>Comments</u></b>	Can be easily maintained to fit into a small space; often used in bonsai culture or trained into a standard.
