<u>Cultural Information – Streptocarpus</u> (strep-toh-KAR-pus)

Light:	Partial sun or shade, an eastern, western or northern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 50°.
Humidity:	Preferably 50% of higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
Watering:	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
Fertilizer:	½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a month. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5.
Pruning:	Remove old flowers, stems and leaves as needed.
Insects and Disease:	Repot once plant has completely filled the pot. These plants can also be divided.
Comments	Avoid wetting the leaves when watering and be sure to use lukewarm water only, as cold water will make spots on the leaves.
