



## The Greenhouses

**Long House:** This warm, tropical greenhouse, kept above 60°, was originally put up for cut-flowers during the 1920s. The side benches held potted plants and soil beds were built into the center of the greenhouse. Here you can find Acalypha, Begonia, Carnivorous, Fruiting, Jasmine, and Many More!

**Big House:** This greenhouse was built in 1940, salvaged from the 1938 hurricane. At the time, it was one of the biggest greenhouses the family had put up, so it was called the Big House. It is a sub-tropical greenhouse, colder than most of the others, with winter temperatures kept to a minimum of 40° - 42° at night. Here you can find Avocados, Brugmansia, Cacti, Camellias, Clivia, Geranium, Jasmine, and Succulents.

**Potting House:** This is where most of the potting was originally done. It is a very bright greenhouse, kept warm, with a minimum temperature of 63° - 65°. Here you can find Herbs, Passiflora, Spice Plants, Strongylodon, and Thunbergia.

**Fern House:** This was the very first, original greenhouse the Logee's business was started in, by William D. Logee, in 1892. It is a warm greenhouse, with temperatures kept above 60°. Here you can find Ferns, Hibiscus, and Terrarium Plants.

**Lemon Tree House:** This was built as an addition to the original greenhouse (the Fern House) and is kept warm, with minimum temperatures of 62° - 64°. Our famous Ponderosa Lemon Tree, now 117 years old, grows here. You can also find Alocasia, Citrus, Colocasia, and Orchids.

**Herb House:** This is a cold, underground greenhouse, where temperatures are kept above the dangers of frost, at a minimum of 38°. Here you can find Bay, Lavender, Rosemary, Sage and Thyme.
